PTA Funds Update

Last year, the PTA raised an astounding **£14,000** for the school and is on track to only better that total this year! Huge thanks to you all for your hard work and contributions which enabled us to fund several improvements for the school, including, artificial grass in the playground, a new long jump pit, a school projector and improved lighting in the hall (both of massive benefit to all our school performances and assemblies), and, event gazebos. We were also able to provide a budget for each teacher for the benefit of their individual classroom.

This year, money raised has already funded the fantastic "Wind in the Willows" theatre company visit which the children were thrilled with. Plans are in progress to install table tennis and football tables in the playground, socket the netball posts to improve their usability and safety, replace the tired curtains in the hall, and reinstate the children's Salmon Prayer Garden.

The PTA works closely with Mr. Mooney and the senior team to coordinate how the funds are used and ensure our hard-raised cash goes as far as possible to benefit our children in their school environment.

Event Round Up

- Infant and Junior Discos Our popular discos took place in October and, once again, it was delightful to see the children enjoying themselves with some serious dance moves on display! Thanks to the hard work of the parent volunteers, this event managed to raise £470 which was more than last year. Well done everyone, great job!
- Quiz Night -The infamous Quiz night took place on November 13th, superbly organised by Jenny MacDonald and a team of Year 6 parents. It was a fun and memorable night and the competition was truly heated. A staggering £1050 was raised! Although this is not PTA run, we thought important to promote to parents as this particular event is a



fundraiser to subsidise the Y6 journey to France in the summer. It's only getting bigger and better make sure you keep your diaries free to book a table next year – come and support our Y6 parents, you won't be disappointed!
