Rounding up the Sheep Adding More Game

This game encourages children to add more to a group. This will help children to see that by adding more, the group of objects becomes larger and the quantity changes.

How to Play

- 1. Shuffle the sheep cards and place them in a pile, facing downwards.
- 2. Choose the colour of your counters.
- 3. The first player takes one card and places it in the box labelled 'First'.
- 4. Count the number of sheep on the card.
- 5. The same player then takes a second card and places this in the second box, labelled 'Then'.
- 6. How many more sheep are there?
- 7. How many sheep are there altogether now? You may want to find the answer by counting all of the sheep or by counting on from the first number.
- 8. Place a coloured counter on the box showing the correct number.
- 9. Take turns to play. If the number you need has already been taken, you must miss a turn.
- 10. The winner is the person with the most counters when all the cards have gone.
