WALT: To make simple size patterns.

Below is a talking repeating pattern. Can you join in with the repeating pattern below? Start off slowly and see how fast you can say the repeating pattern!

Today I would like you to make a pattern according to size. You can do this however you like, you could use playdough, your toys, some items from your kitchen etc or you might want to make some bunting for your party on Friday. You can use the heart bunting worksheet if you want. If so, print out the hearts and make a pattern according to their size, then attach the hearts together using string or wool to make your bunting. It could be a simple pattern e.g. big blue heart, small blue heart, big blue heart, small blue heart etc or it could be more complex e.g. Big blue heart, pink big blue heart, small blue heart, small pink heart, big blue heart, pink big blue heart, small blue heart, small pink heart etc.
