Adding a Headline

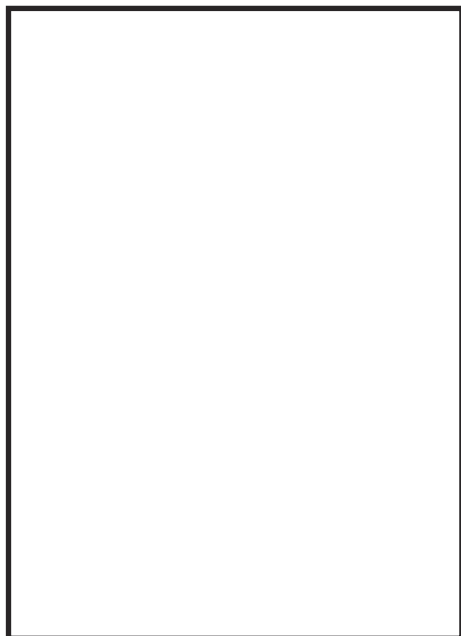
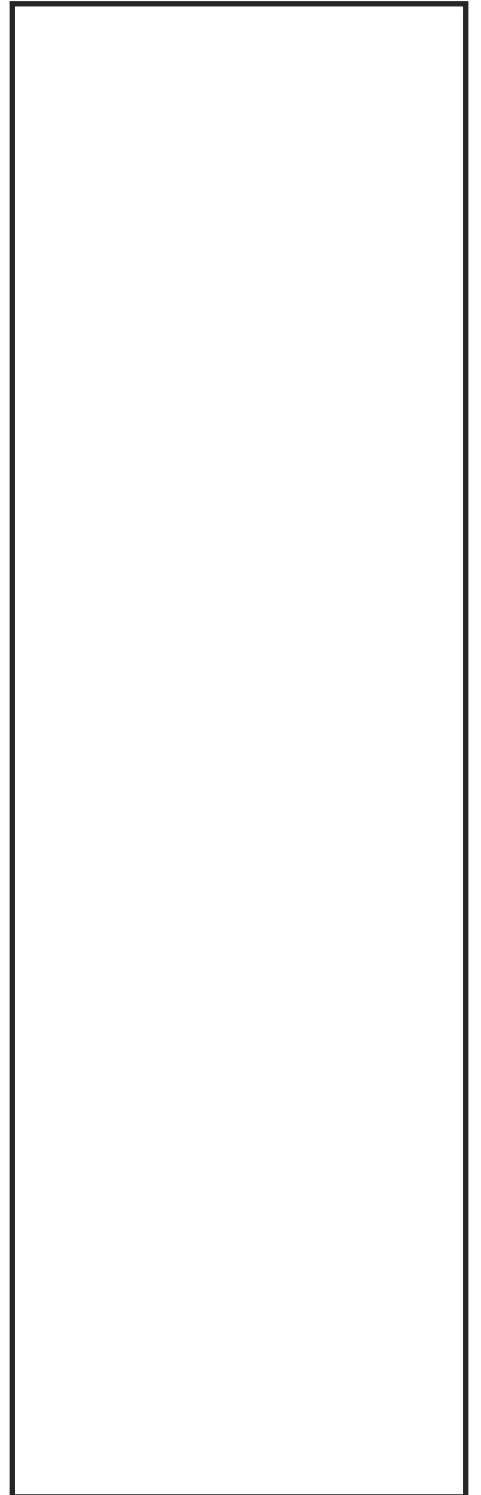
Think of a short, informative headline. It can be a play on words or even alliteration.

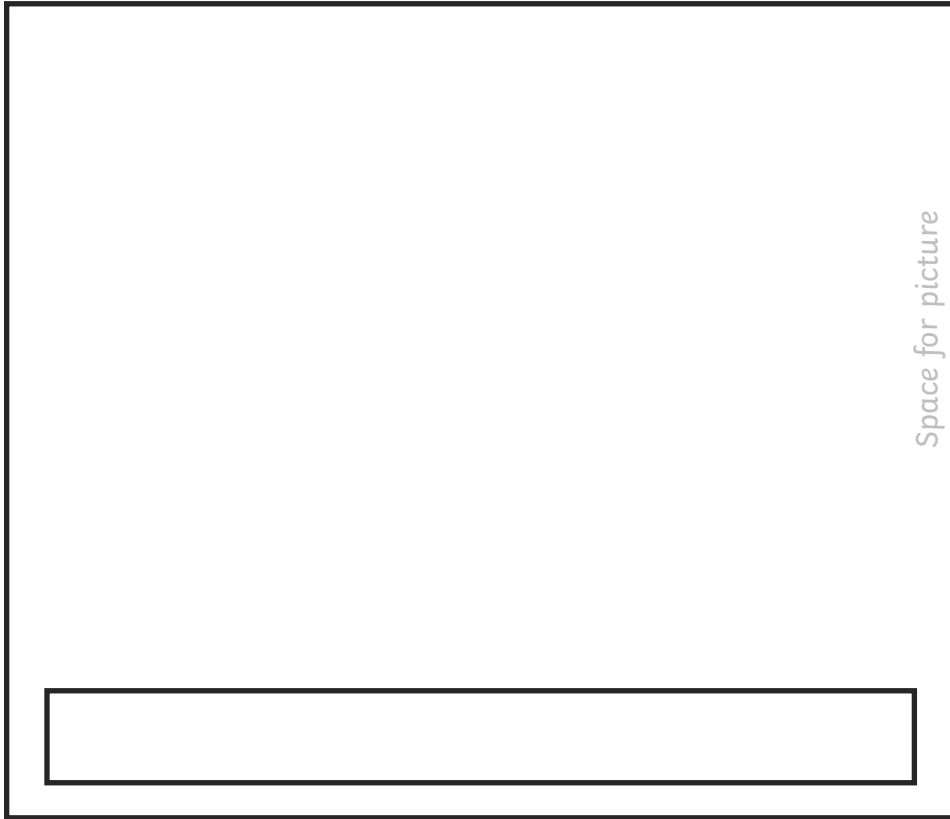
Adding Quotes

Adding quotes would add 'believability' to your report. You could use quotes from the Bible, or imagine what the eye witnesses would say.

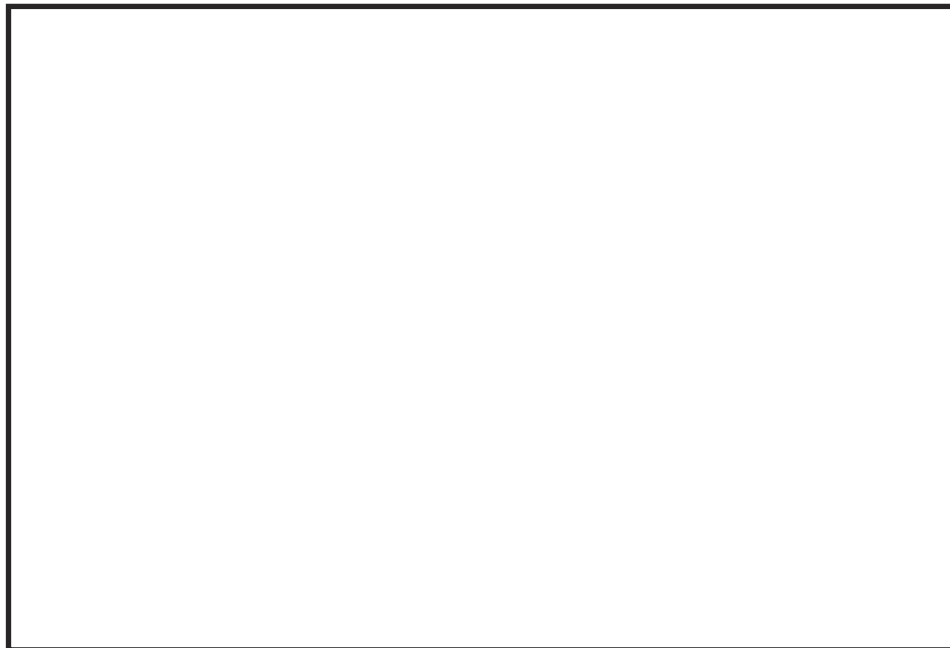
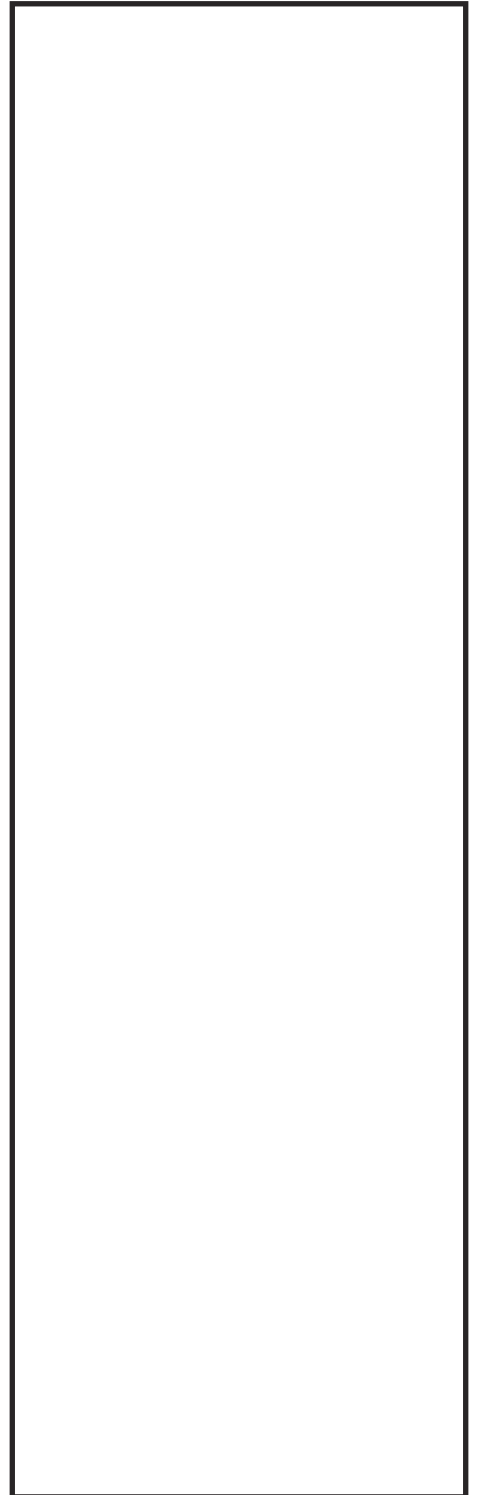


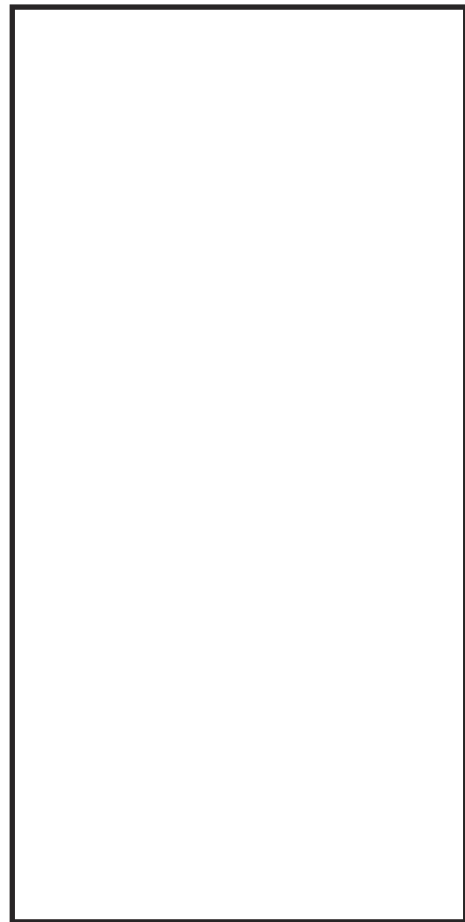
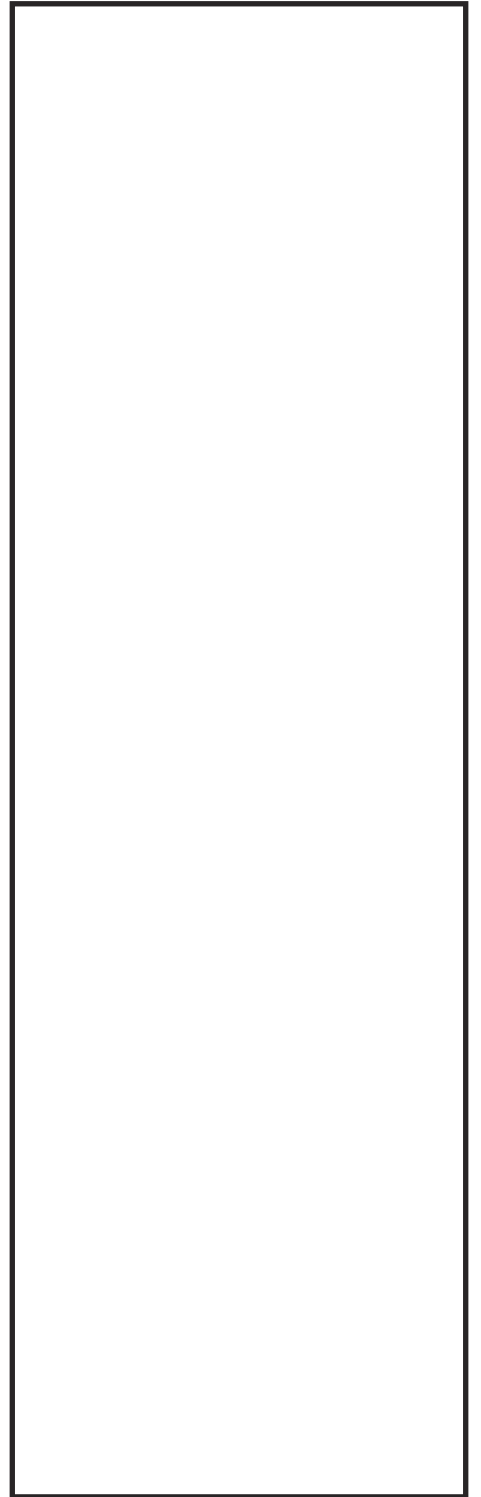
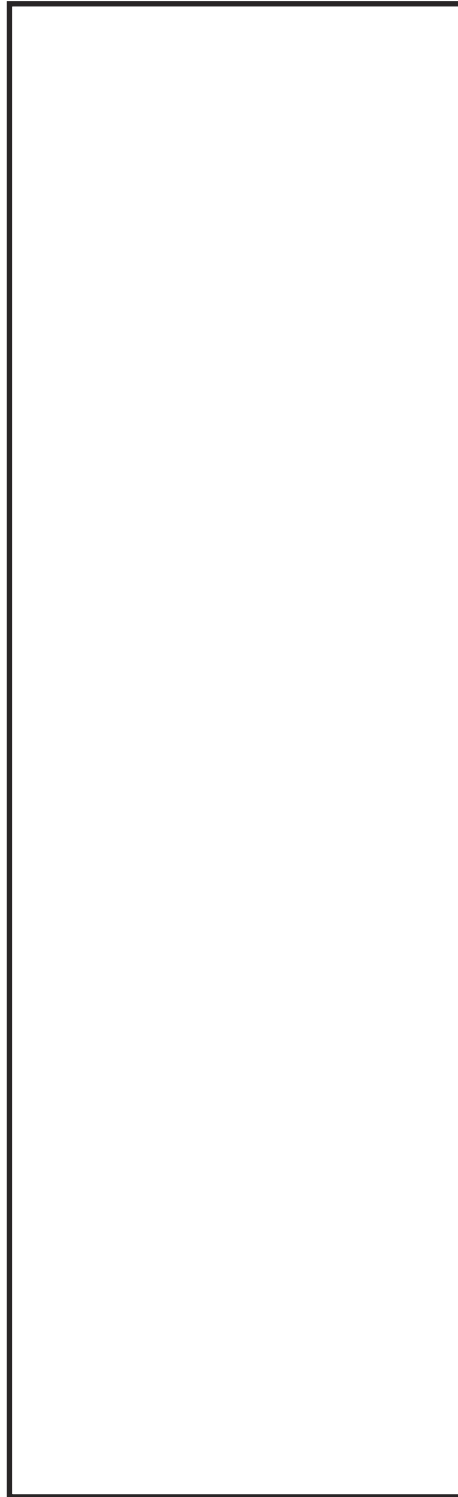
