

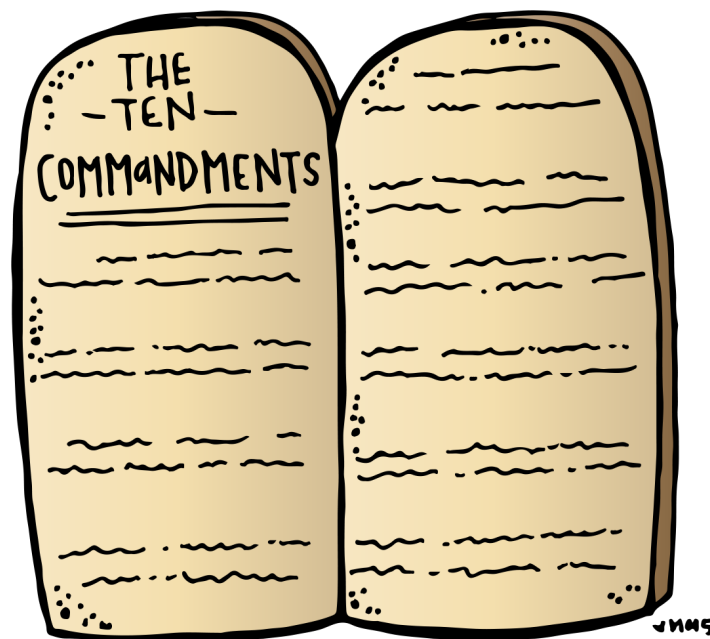
Hi Blue Class,
