

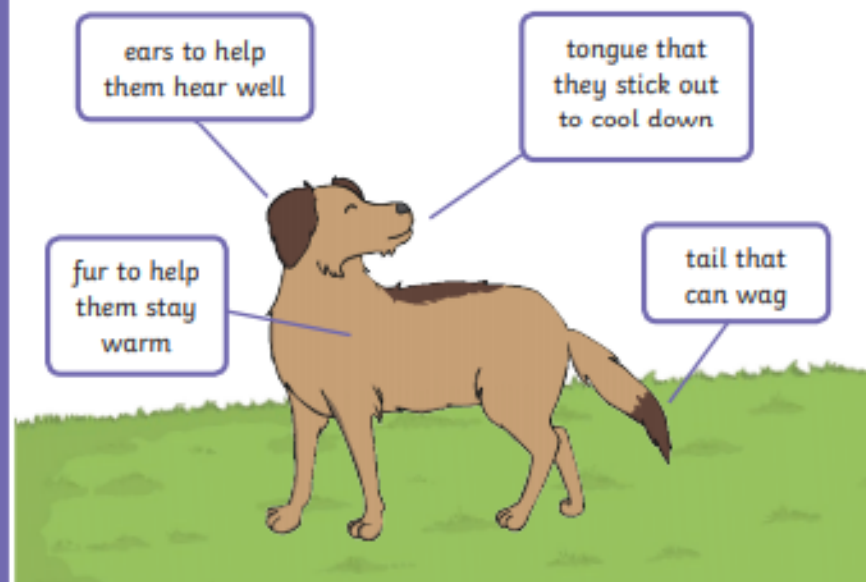
Taking Care of a Dog
