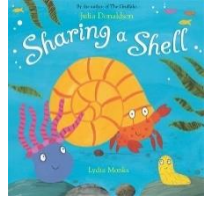


English: Writing

Hello Orange Class 😊 Over the next few weeks we are going to be looking at lots of different Julia Donaldson books and completing some writing activities based around them. This week's book is called 'Sharing a Shell'.



Activity 1: Listen to the story of sharing a shell. Here is the link to the story:

Activity 2: Designing time! Crab needs a new and bigger shell for him and his friends and he wants Orange Class to help him with this. He asked that Orange class design him a new shell that he can use every day. Think about what is needed for his shell during everyday life and what you think he may like on it too.

Once you have designed your shell and labelled all the different features, write a description of the shell using lots of different adjectives for Crab.
