


We are continuing to learn about odd and even numbers. Today we are going to think about odd numbers. Odd numbers are numbers that will have one left over when grouped into pairs.

- Step 1: Make some number cards 1-10.
- Step 2: Either print out the tens frame or draw your own one.
- Step 3: Pick a number.
- Step 4: Using objects and your chosen number put the right number of objects onto your tens frame.
- Step 5: Decide if it is an odd or an even number. Remember, if all of the objects have a partner then it is an even number. If one of your objects does not have a partner, then it is an odd number.
