

## Green ideas

Children learn that words take particular roles (functions) in sentences. Help your child by brainstorming lots of different types of word – e.g. describing words (adjectives) and combining these in odd sentences.

## What to do...

**1.** A famous linguist, Chomsky, once wrote a strange sentence to show how words do different 'jobs' within a grammatical sentence:

Green ideas sleep furiously

adjective noun verb adverb

describing name of a thing or person an action word action is done
