I'm beside myself with glee,

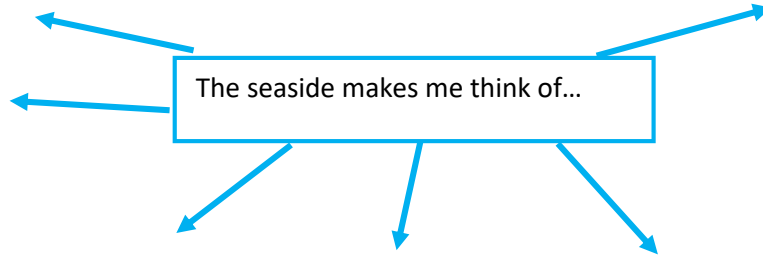
Beside the seaside, beside the sea.
