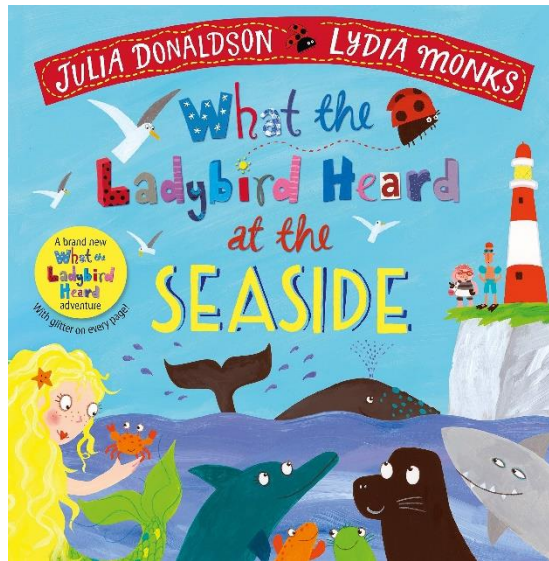


English: Writing
