We have had another busy and exciting week in Reception.

We have introduced another three new letter sounds 'n', 'l', 'p' and the children are becoming much more confident at blending CVC words (a CVC word is a word that is made up of a consonant, vowel and consonant sound, for example: dog, cat, mat, dad).

We have now finished our first topic in RE 'Myself'. The children enjoyed learning about how special they are and how much God loves them. Next week we will be learning about Judaism.
