Croydon's <u>Best Start</u> programme gives their parents and parents-to-be support and help by coordinating the work of health visitors, midwives, early learning practitioners, family nurses, children's centres and voluntary and community organisations.

This means parents only have to explain their situation once and the network of 400 professionals, who are part of the programme, can then tailor a package of support suited to each individual set of circumstances.
