#### **School Uniform**

I've noticed that observance of correct school uniform is slightly haphazard for some pupils. May I remind you all that correct school uniform should be worn at all times; this includes hairbands and bobbles in school colours whenever hair should be tied back (over collar length) and also correct school coats. I attach a copy of the school uniform policy for your reference. Please also note that the school policy on prohibiting earrings remains. A policy amendment this term, taking account of infection control, has been to ask families to send pupils in to school in their school tracksuits and PE kit on PE days. This will remain until further notice.

As often said in newsletters, in order to return lost uniform to pupils we need it to be labelled. Please check as uniform is expensive.
