In school our Advent focus is 'Hope' and we have been thinking about what we hope for during Advent and Christmas, we continue to also focus on Kindness during this time.

This Sunday, 6th December, parish mass should resume so do try to attend if you are able. Mass is streamed from almost all parishes and, as we enter the Christmas season, and perhaps more importantly than ever this year, we need to put our trust in God and spend time with him in prayer.

School updates

We welcomed back most of Year 4 this week after their isolation period came to an end. Year 6 Violet class will return to school on Tuesday 8th. Thank you all for remaining vigilant and please remember do not send your child to school if they have any symptoms of COVID 19.

Christmas in school will look slightly different this year: please read the following arrangements.

Christmas Jumper Day for Save the Children

Friday 11th December. This has become a festive favourite, please wear your Christmas jumper (and mufti) to support this worthy charity. Save the Children ask for a £2 donation. Please send the money in an envelope. It will be collected in classes and then quarantined and counted in the last week of term.

Christmas Cards

We have thought carefully about this and have decided we can do this but a little differently. Each class will have their own Christmas postbox. Children can only send cards within their own bubble. and in order to do this as safely as possible we have been advised to ask the children not to lick the envelopes and we are going to have to quarantine them before we can give them out. In order to quarantine them we therefore ask that all Christmas Cards are posted in the class boxes by Friday 11th December. They will then be quarantined and handed out in the last couple of days of term.

Christmas Hats

Having thought about this a little more we have decided that Christmas hats will be made in classes this year to avoid them having to come in from home. We will ensure we have plenty of pom poms, glitter and

sparkles in order to achieve this. We will make them and wear them on Christmas Dinner Day. (Wednesday 16th December) No competition this year

Wednesday 16th December. Some classes will eat in the hall (socially distanced) and some will eat in their classrooms. Please pay for this on parentpay in the usual way. The children may wear their Christmas jumper again on this day – over their uniform.
