## **Parent Surveys**

Thank you, everyone, for completing the Parent Survey on distanced learning and return to school. Your feedback is so important and we do take account of it in shaping what we do and plan to do. I attach a summary of the feedback we received.

I'm sorry that the **RSE Survey** initially had a restriction box ticked that made it difficult to access. I wrote earlier in the week with a revised link and extended the deadline to the end of today. To date we have received 42 responses; thanks to everyone who has responded. We'll analyse the outcomes and write back to you with a summary, especially related to the feedback about the key decisions.

## **Assemblies and Liturgy**

Yesterday was the Feast of the Ascension. We held a zoom liturgy with our children to celebrate this Holy Day. In usual times we would celebrate mass in school. We sent out the Wednesday Word earlier in the week and encourage you to use it as a resource to pray with your children. We are ensuring that the prayer life of our school is distinctive and vibrant, especially in a time when the school cannot meet together in person. ## Notification of water main replacement work

We have been made aware that water main replacement work will be taking place in both The Bridle Road and Russell Hill. This includes full water main replacement of both roads and is likely to be quite disruptive. The Bridle Road will be closed from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> May until into August. Russell Hill will have temporary traffic lights and disruption from 26<sup>th</sup> July all the way through to February 2022. It is hard to ascertain at this point how the disruption to usual traffic will affect us, but it is unlikely to improve traffic flow. It's most likely to affect us in Russell Hill in September, when schools traffic resumes.
